Theme 4 Overview:

- **Title – How Does Heat Cause Change?** What happens to water and ice at various temperatures? – Students will be learning that the properties of substances can change when the substances are mixed, cooled, or heated. They will be learning the physical properties of water, ice, and steam.
- Vocabulary words – melt, liquid, observe, fill, sign, freeze
- Phonics – Short “u” and “ip” (**hip**) and “in” (**fin**) families
- Phonemic Awareness – phoneme blending: onset and rime
- Grammar – telling sentence and asking sentence

2. I have big feet.
3. I have short, curly hair
